Responsibilities

The overall responsibility for this position is to provide pre-sales support and installation services for netRelevance's Networking, DataComm, Security, Video and Low Voltage service offerings. Other responsibilities include:

- Provide pre-sales and post sales support through requirements gathering, proposal development, cost-benefit analysis, and delivery of technical presentations.

- If necessary leading the installation team(s) to ensure we are exceeding customer expectations
- Work within the Business Development team to develop technical documents such as proposals, product specifications, RFP, RFI, and RFQ responses, Visio diagrams, Bills of Materials, and Labor estimates.



- Create and deliver recommended network designs, technical proposals, and presentations to customers.
- Effectively answer any questions regarding the proposed solution which may include questions about installation and configuration.

- Actively engage in recruiting of Low Voltage and deployment resources.

Requirements

The ideal candidate will have a well-rounded technical knowledge of networking, hands-on low-voltage installation experience, and a proven history of successful interaction with customers in a selling context. Other requirements include:

- In-depth knowledge and understanding of networking technologies, design principles, and the practical application of routers and switches.
- Experience gathering business requirements, designing technical solutions, and presenting proposed designs to customers.
- Familiarity with IP Convergence including the design and implementation of IP Telephony (IPT) / Voice over IP (VoIP) solutions (CallManager, Unity, MeetingPlace, IPCC, or IPCC Express) is a strong plus.
- Strong documentation skills and prior experience generating technical documents, proposals, product specifications, and responses to RFPs, RFIs or RFQs.
- Knowledge of Network Security solutions (Firewalls, IDS/IPS, VPN, Host Based Security Solutions) is a strong plus.
- Experience working on Government projects and having security clearance is a plus. Must be able to obtain a security clearance if no current security clearance.
- Proficiency with Microsoft Word, Excel, and Visio is a must.
- A Bachelor's Degree (BS) in Computer Science, Information Systems, Electrical Engineering or a related technical discipline is required.
- BICSI Communications Distribution Designer (RCDD) Certification is required.
- Cisco Certifications such as CCNA and/or CCDA are a strong plus.
- The ability to travel to other markets if necessary up to 40% of the time.
- Must possess a valid Colorado driver's license.
- Must own transportation and have updated automobile insurance.
- A minimum of 5 years experience performing network design and engineering experience and/or low-voltage infrastructure design and installation.
